ADORATION

[Jesus] answered, "Have you not read that He who created them from the beginning made them male and female, and said, 'Therefore a man shall leave his father and his mother and hold fast to his wife, and the two shall become one flesh'? So they are no longer two but one flesh. What therefore God has joined together, let not man separate." Matt 19:4-6 (ESV)

- Praise and thank God for His creation of mankind in His image. Meditate on Genesis 1:26-28 and Revelation 7:9-12.
- Praise God for His good design in family. Thank Him for your family not only by birth but in Christ! (see Ex 20:12, Ps 68:6, Mal 4:6, Eph 2:19-22, Rom 8:16)



INTERCESSION

- Pray for spouses to increase in Christlikeness, selflessness, grace, and forgiveness. May they walk in humility and honor one another above themselves. (Phil 2:3, Rom 12:9-10).
- Pray for our culture to recognize the sacredness of marriage. Ask for the Holy Spirit to convict of sin, righteousness and judgment (John 16:8)
- Ask God to stir up a hunger for righteousness among parents and children to seek Him first. May parents turn to their children and their children to turn back to them. (Matthew 5:6 & 6:33, Luke 1:17, Exodus 20:12, Psalm 68:6, Malachi 4:6).
