The Nations



ADORATION

"In my vision at night I looked, and there before me was one like a son of man, coming with the clouds of heaven. He approached the Ancient of Days and was led into His presence. He was given authority, glory and sovereign power; all nations and peoples of every language worshiped Him. His dominion is an everlasting dominion that will not pass away, and His kingdom is one that will never be destroyed." Daniel 7:13-14 (NIV)

- Meditate on this passage and Jesus' (the Son of Man's) everlasting Kingdom!
- Praise God for His sovereign plan from the beginning of time to bring all nations and peoples together in worship. (See also Revelation 7:9-12 and Acts 17:24-30)



INTERCESSION

"[For the Lord your God]...defends the cause of the fatherless and the widow, and loves the foreigner residing among you, giving them food and clothing. And you are to love those who are foreigners, for you yourselves were foreigners in Egypt." Deuteronomy 10:17-19, NIV

- Pray Deuteronomy 10:17-19 over all (approx.) 622,000 immigrants in Ohio. Ask Jesus to conform our hearts to His. May we love our neighbors and the new Americans living among us as He commands. (See Lev 19:33-34, 24:22, Ps 146:9, Matt 25:35, & Gal 3:28)
- Pray for us to extend generous, welcoming hospitality to those who are foreign-born.
- Pray for the Lord to work powerfully through immigrant churches to reach new Americans and refugees with the light of the gospel. May they come to repentance through revelation of Jesus' love and the Holy Spirit penetrating their hearts.

Pray for a dramatic decrease in addictions, crime, and mental health issues.
